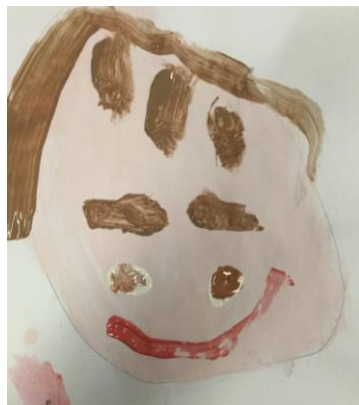


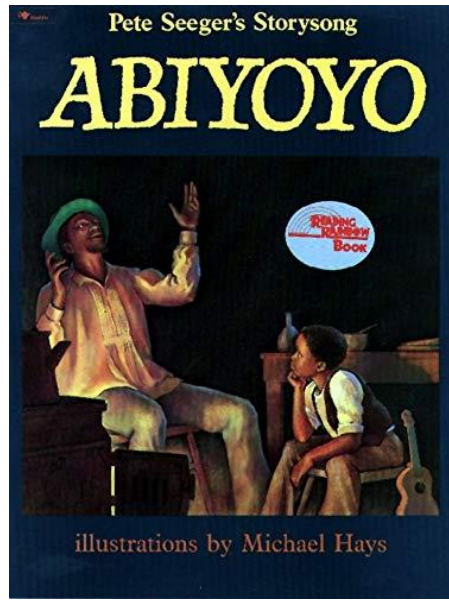
We painted our features on our self portraits.

We thought about what makes us unique. What colour was your hair? Was it long or short? What colour were your eyes?



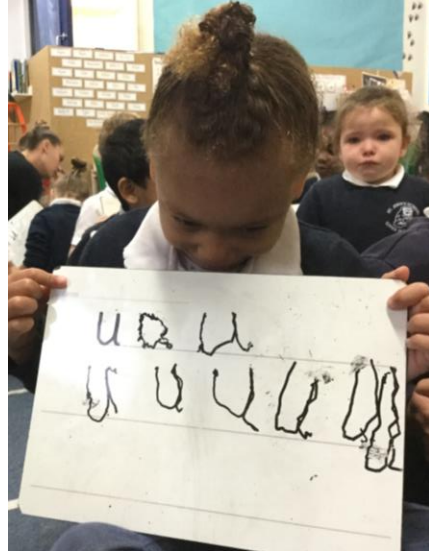
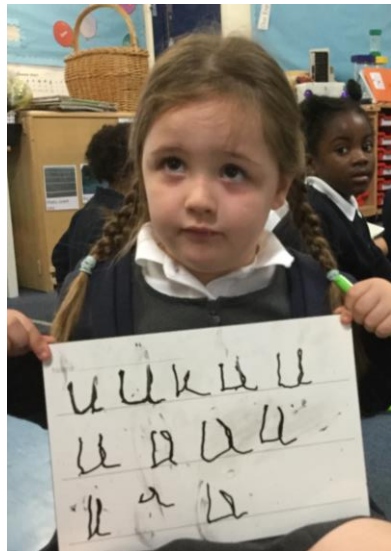
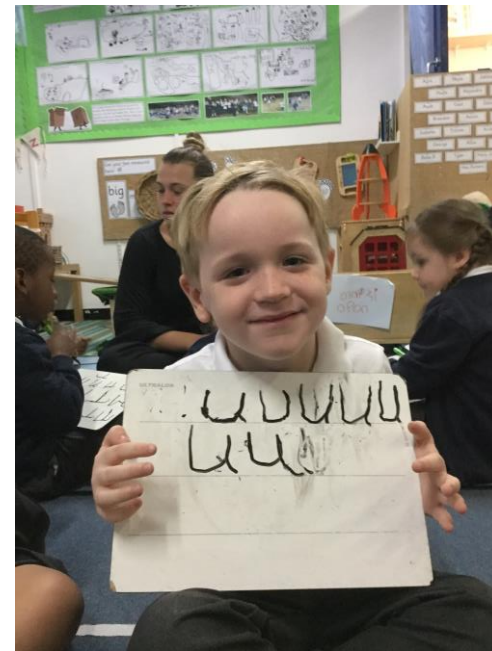
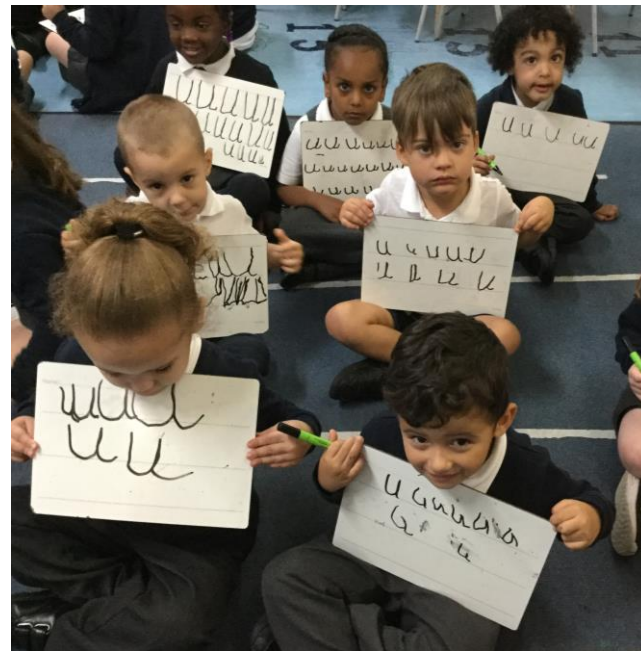

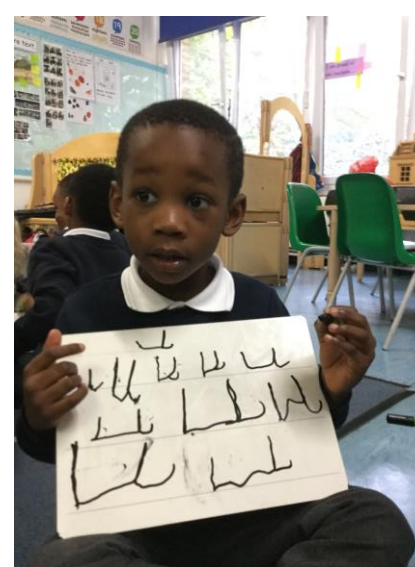


As part of our Black History Month learning we have been learning about the story Abiyoyo. We played the ukulele just like the character in the story!

The children were not happy that I had more and they had fewer! After lots of learning about more and fewer we decided to share them so that every child could have 1 skittle.



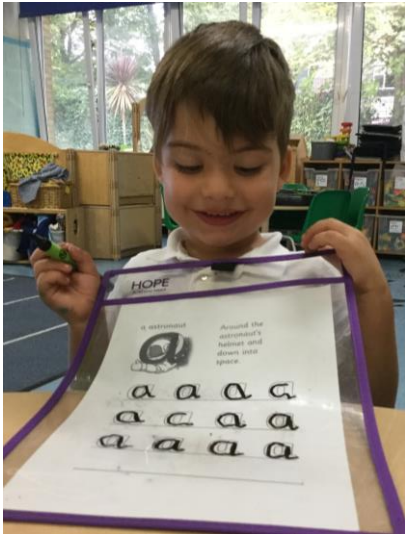
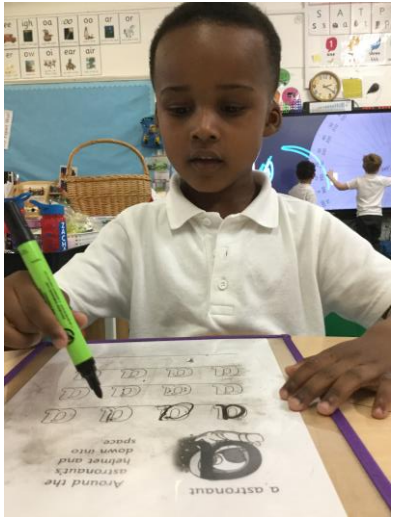
