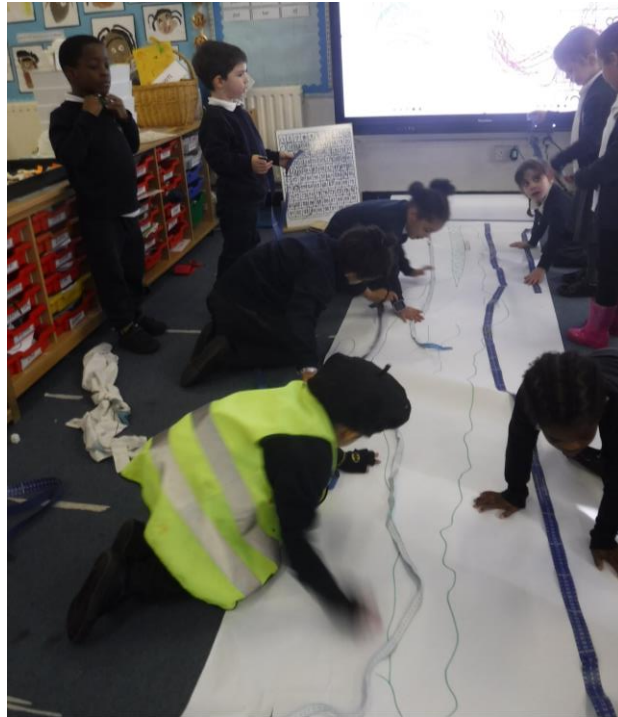
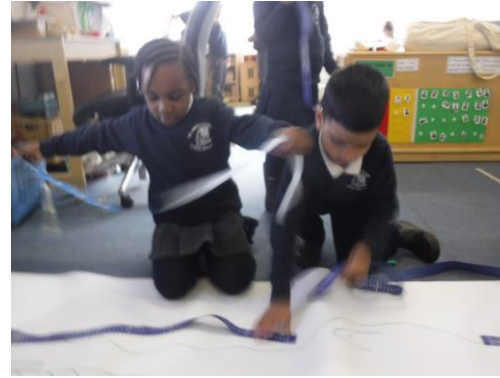

what happened next?

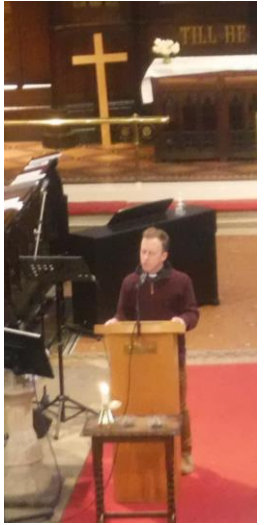

How did you make your pancakes?





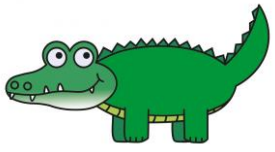
