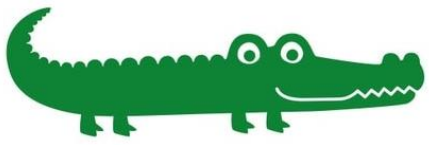
This week we have been counting crocodiles!



Did you find it tricky to pull the snapping crocodiles off your clothes?

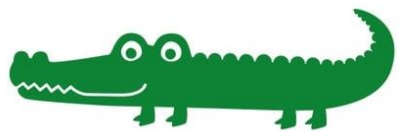


How many crocodiles did you count?

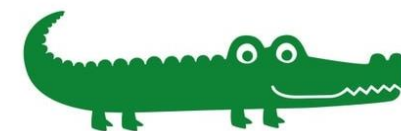


We have been chalking crocodiles.
