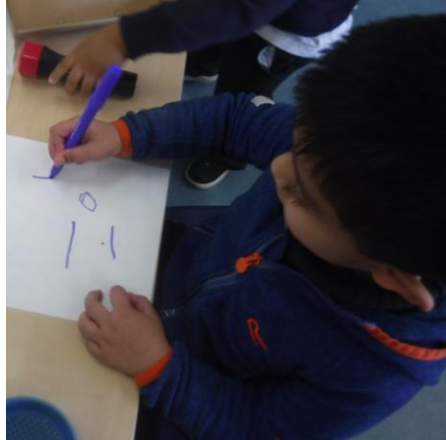
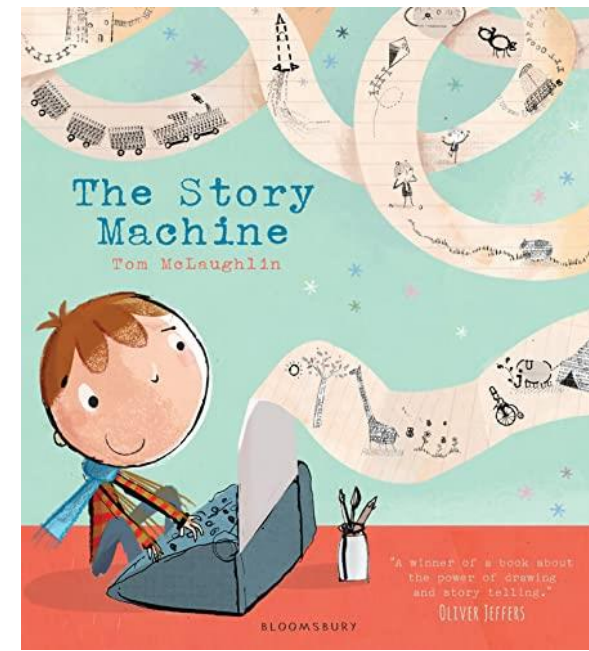


We have been learning

How many cakes did you give to the teddies?





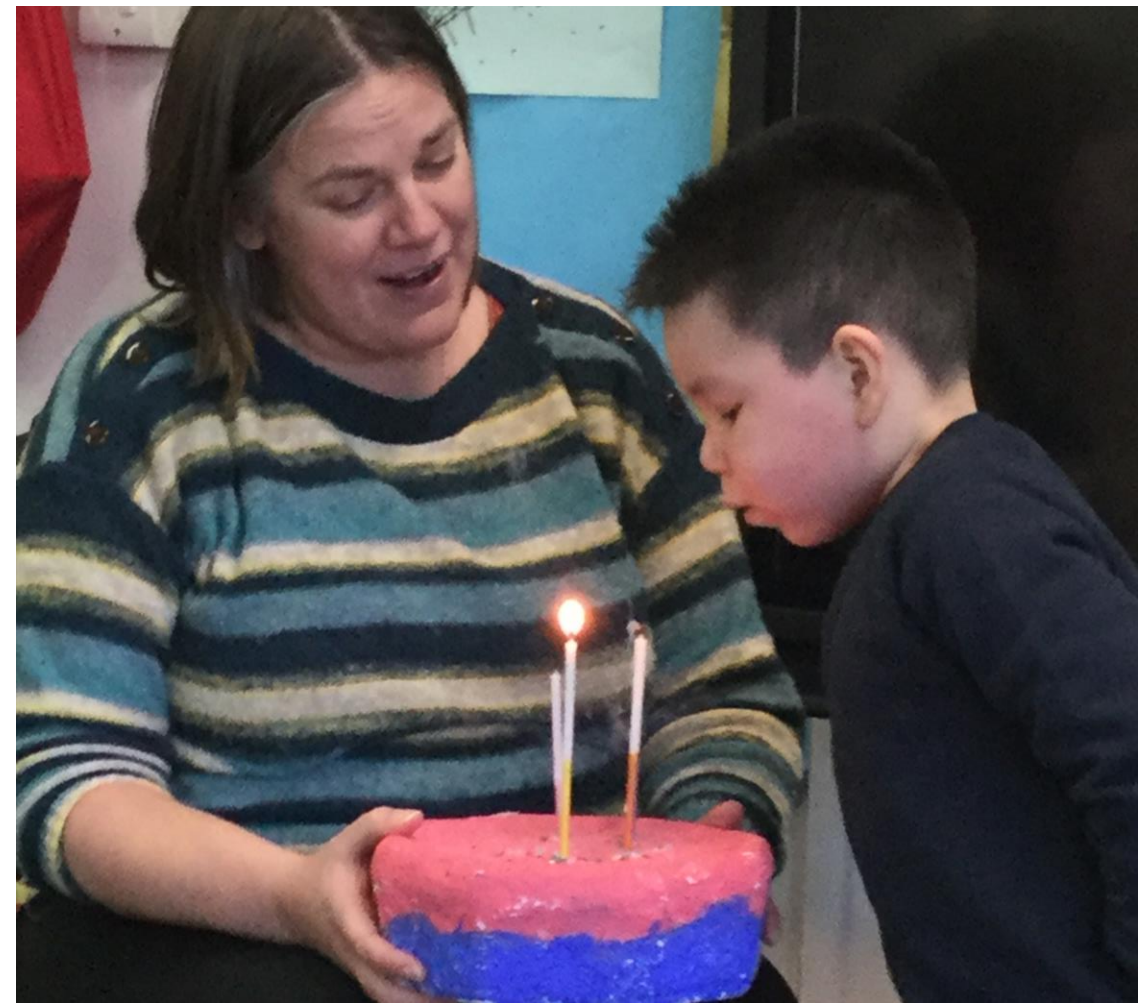
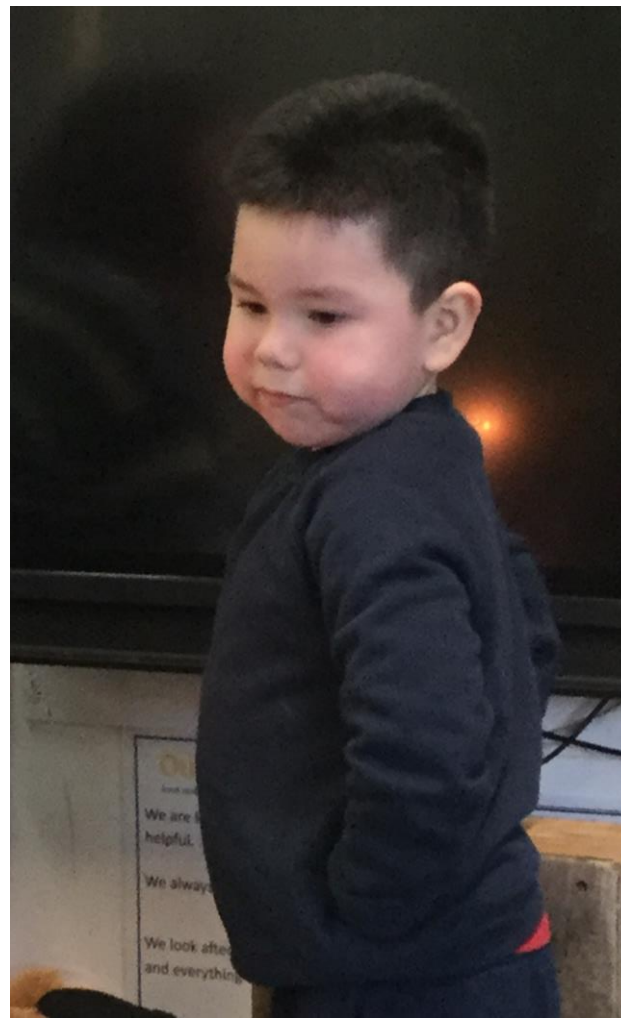
We have been using playdough to explore the Numicon.
