





your garden?




We learnt insects help our plants produce seeds. Which creatures lived in your garden?






We've also been continuing to work on our subitising!
How many plants did you see in the flower shop?






We've been looking at our planted seeds carefully. Can you explain what is happening to your plant now?



We've been making seed bombs with Miss Carol.




This afternoon we planted them.
