Instructions for using our Purple Mash blog

First, you will need to log on to Purple Mash - you should have the laminated password cards at home as we handed them to everyone a week or so ago.

Search Purple Mash in any search engine e.g. Google. When you find the log in page you will need to check you are accessing the St John's Upper Holloway Purple Mash portal. You may need to click the 'Find my school's login page' button:



Then, you can put in the postcode or name of the school: N19 5RR or St Johns Upper Holloway and **double** click on the school as the option comes up.
