Attendance and punctuality

Our attendance is still well below our target of 96% but is gradually creeping up towards this figure. Our home-school support officer, Peter, is working with families where attendance is well below what is expected and aims to provide support wherever possible. We ask that families do not take holidays during term time and in line with local authority guidance, we may have to impose a penalty notice on families who do so. If there are exceptional circumstances why you may need to take your child out of school during term time, please speak with the school in advance so that we can discuss whether such absence can be authorized.
