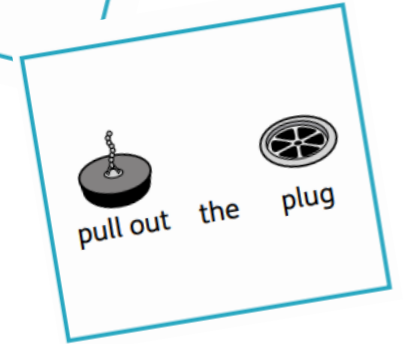




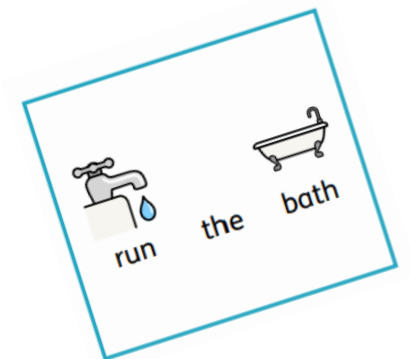
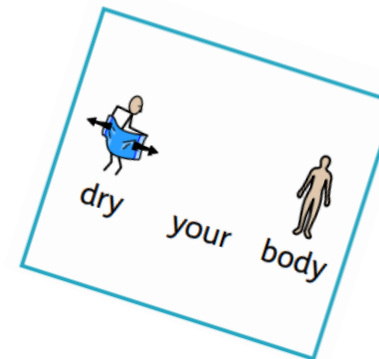


We gave our Bog baby a bath! Can you remember the order you do things when you have a bath?

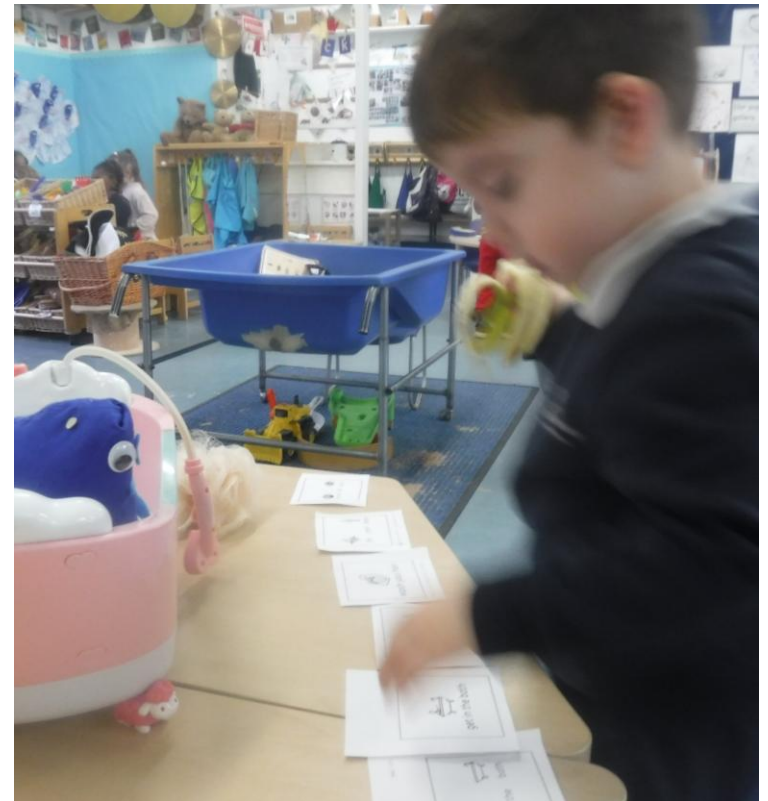




Did you remember to fill the bath? Which part of the Bog baby did you wash first? Did you dry him at the beginning or the end of his bath?



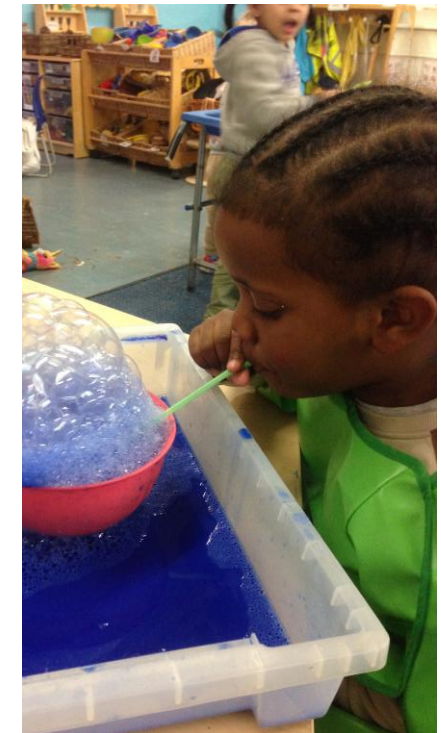








We made bubble printing pictures. Did you remember to blow through the straw? Don't suck the bubble mixture up!

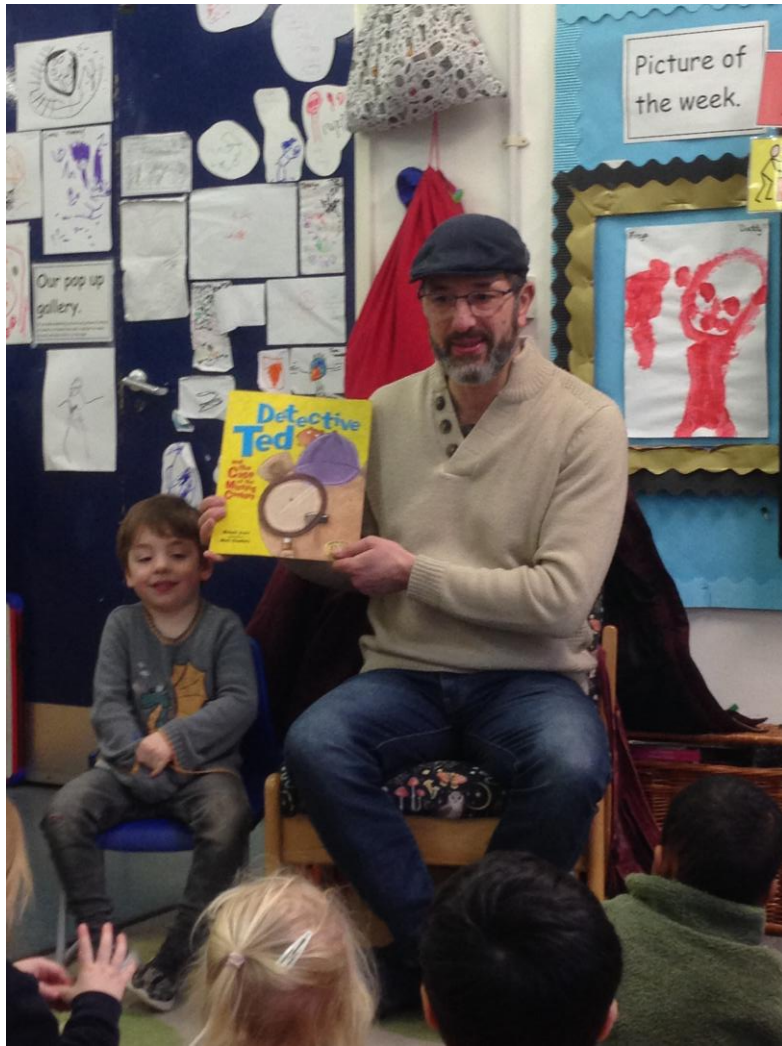







The bubble prints were just like the magic pond where the Bog babies lived!
