
This week we have been exploring the signs of Spring. What can you see, hear and smell that helps you know Spring is coming?









We looked carefully at crocodiles and drew our own. Did you remember to include a bumpy back, sharp teeth and a long tail? Which colours did you need to use?









We have been printing with flowers. The flowers made different shapes on the paper, there were small flowers and large ones.









