
This week we thought we'd share some wonderful memories of learning we have done over the last year!



Our carnival week was very popular! The children enjoyed making their costumes and celebrating with their friends.




Diwali was another fantastic festival celebration!






We have been able to show our self confidence by trying new things, and talking about what we like and don't like. It's been fun to discover we are not all the same, and that we like and dislike different flavours.

We have practiced our maths skills every day! We are learning by trying out new things, and making connections between what we know and what we see happening.






We are working hard to get our woodworking licences! We know how to use the tools with care and how to keep ourselves safe!
