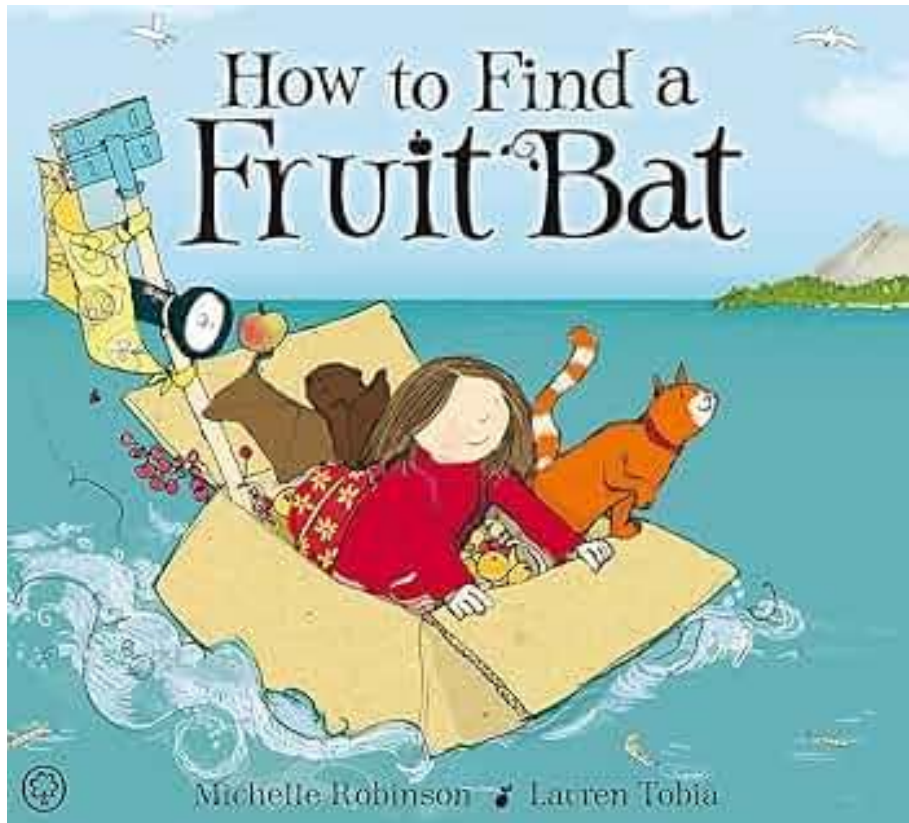
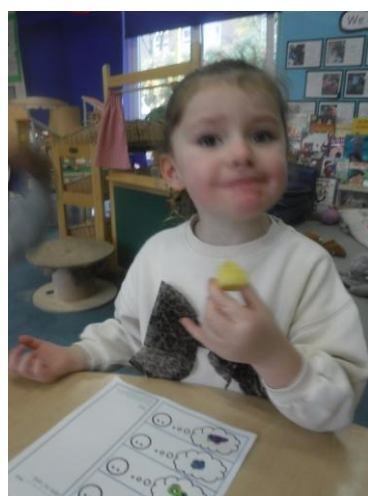
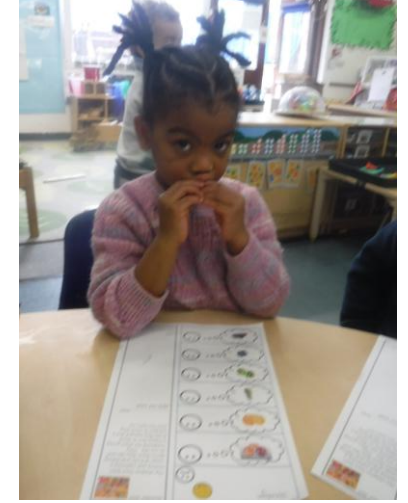


What we have been learning about...

This week we have been exploring fruit! We tasted to check which we liked the best and then made a chart to decide what was our class favourite! What do you think it was?



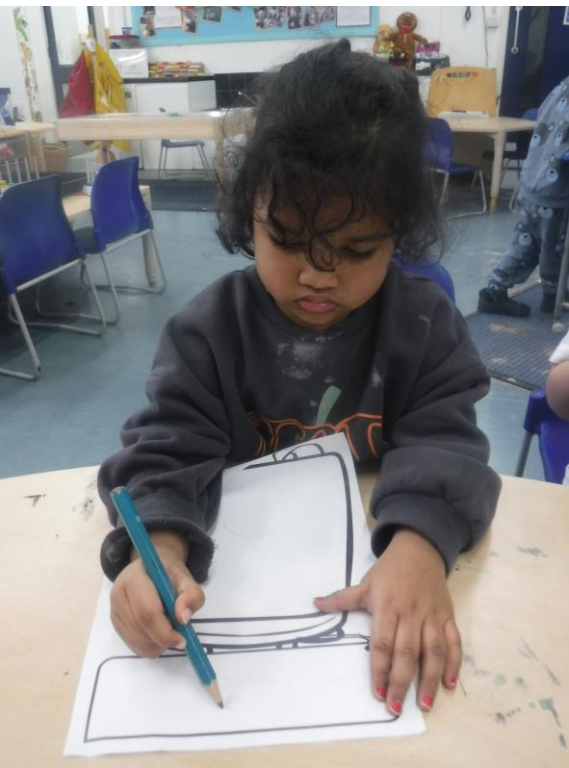


Most children liked bananas the best!

What did you think you might need to take if you were hunting for fruit bats?

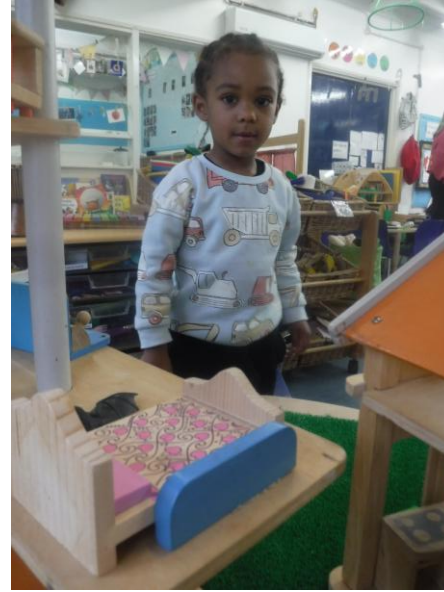


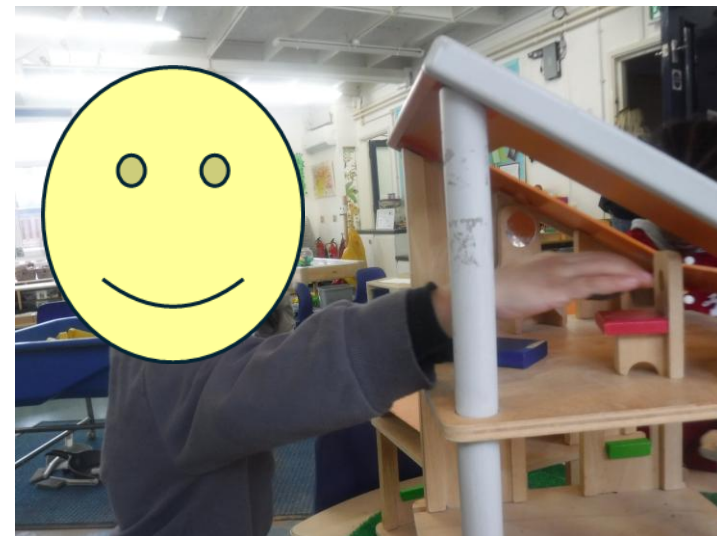


We've been playing hide and seek with bats in the doll's house!
