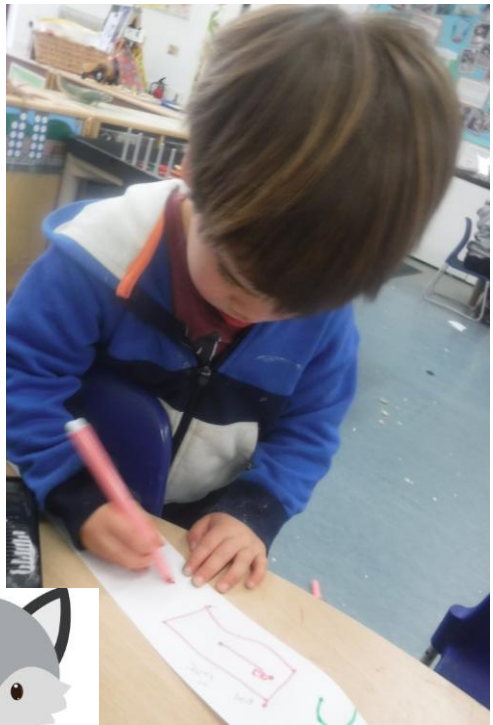
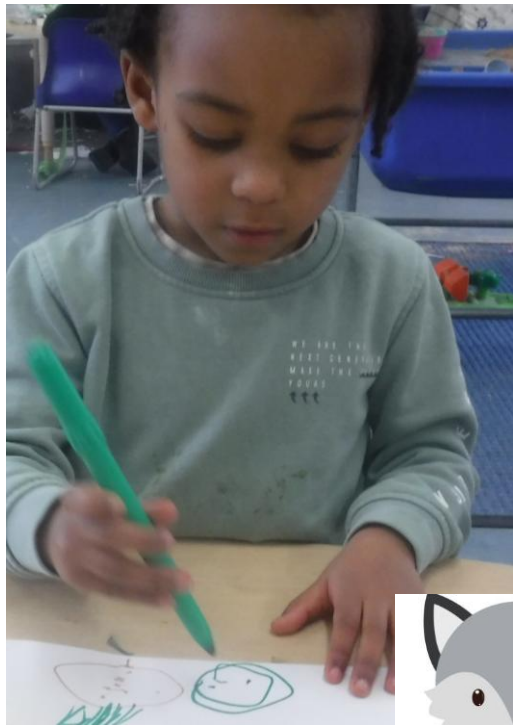




What is your favourite fairytale?

Who is your favourite character?



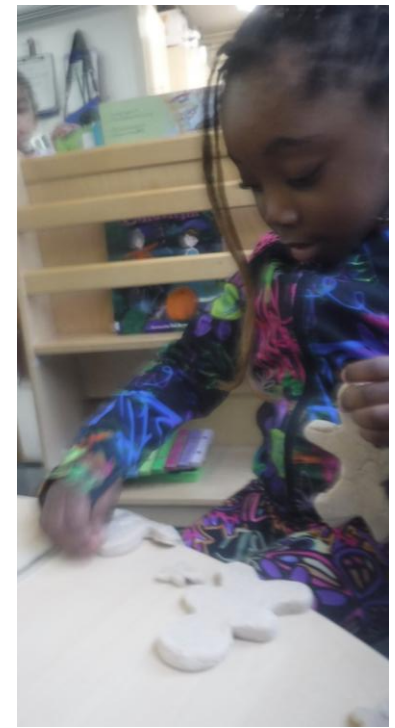
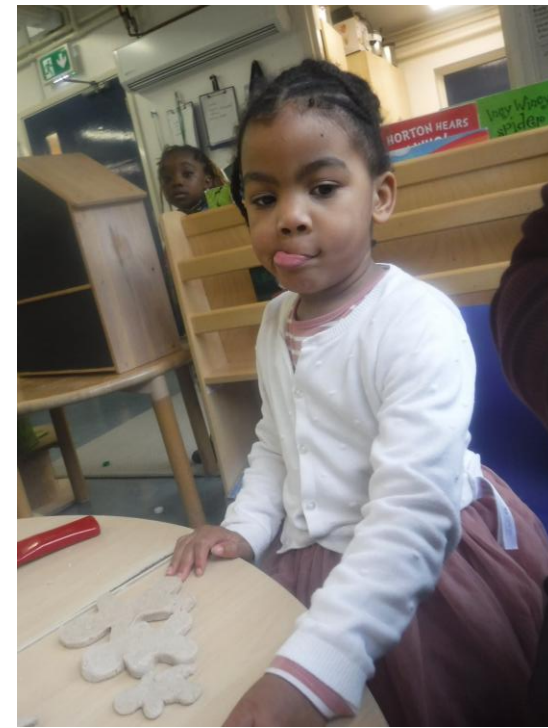
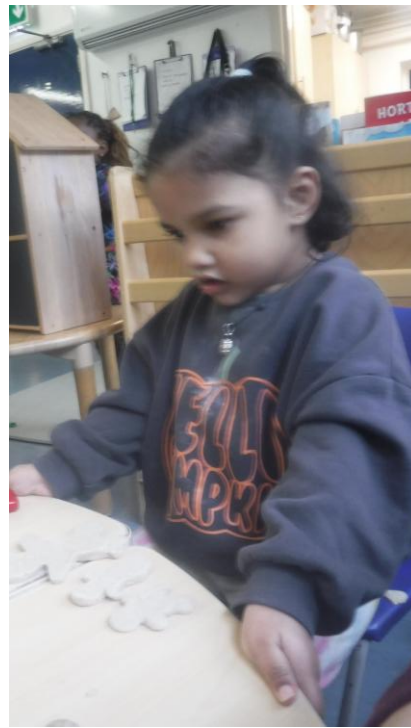






We've been thinking about the gingerbread man story too, and practicing our measuring. Which gingerbread man was the tallest? Or the shortest?





What was the best way of measuring your gingerbread men? How could you tell which was taller or shorter?



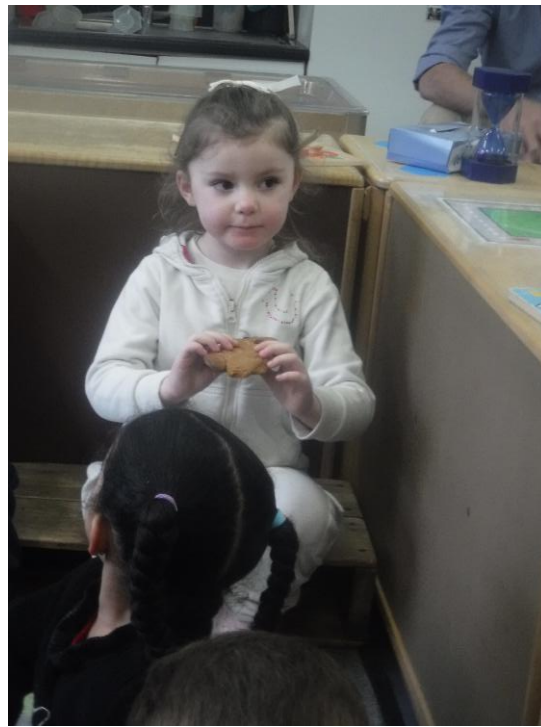


We also made real gingerbread men with Miss Carol. What did we need to remember to do before we started cooking? Why?
