


What we have been learning about...

This week we have been celebrating Chinese New Year. We set our home corner up as a Chinese restaurant.




We celebrated

We also had our Ash Wednesday service at St John's Church.












We used 2D shapes to make our own Chinese dragons. Could you name the shapes you used? How many different shapes did you have?






It has been exciting to have more Mummy and Daddy visitors this week to read our story at the end of the day!




