

# What we have been learning about...

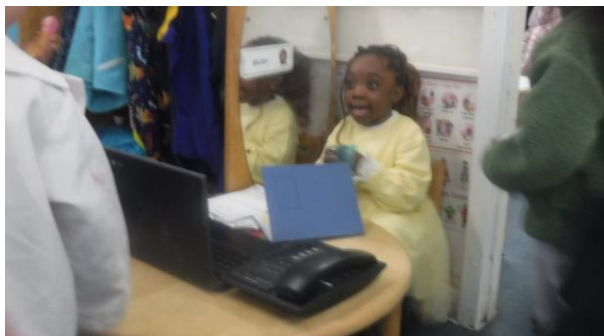
26<sup>th</sup> January to 30<sup>th</sup> January 2025

We filled our Bog baby bodies with sawdust and seeds. We used pipecleaners for arms and cut out felt feet. We gave our magical Bog babies little wings.



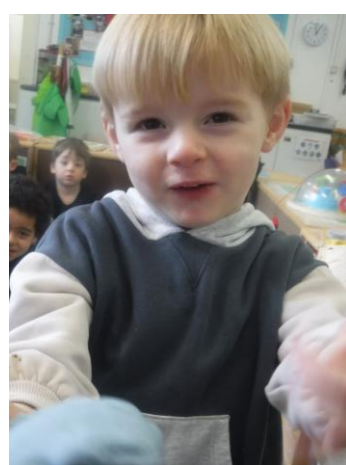




We've also been thinking

something that is light?





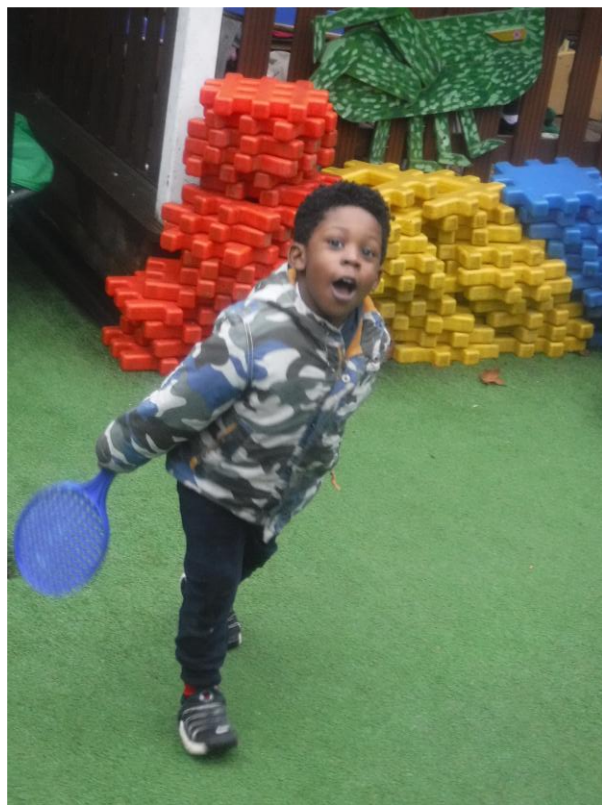
